<p>1. Pull the alarm and Call 9-1-1</p>	<p>1. If a weather warning is issued or severe or threatening weather approaches move to a safe shelter area.</p>	<p>1. If the incident is occurring near you, SECURE-IN-PLACE in a safe space where you are.</p>	<p>1. Exit the building if advised by Emergency Personnel and seek a safe rally site upwind of the building.</p>
<p>2. Evacuate the building utilizing the nearest safe exit.</p>	<p>Notification is through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Outdoor Warning Sirens and/or HawkAlert messaging. 	<p>2. If you can leave, EVACUATE immediately, Call 9-1-1 if you have information about the incident.</p>	<p>OR</p> <p>SHELTER-IN-PLACE:</p>
<p>3. Meet at the building's designated rally sites: Center Courtyard North side sidewalk Cleary Walkway</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ii. Local TV or Radio iii. Apps like FEMA, NOAA, etc... 	<p>Otherwise RUN – Plan an escape route, leave belongings behind, when safe call 9-1-1.</p>	<p>1. CLOSE and seal all doors and windows</p>
<p>4. Follow the instructions of Emergency Action Team Coordinators, Police Fire/EMS personnel</p>	<p>WEATHER SHELTERS</p>	<p>HIDE – Locate an interior room – lock door, block with furniture, turn off lights, silence devices, avoid windows and doors.</p>	<p>2. SHUT OFF any room air sources (vents, air conditioners, etc.) and call Work Control Center 335-5071</p>
<p>Persons with Disabilities: ASSIST in relocating the person to the nearest safe fire rated stairwell and INFORM the nearest emergency responder of their location.</p>	<p>2. Seek an area away from windows, in hallways, or the basement of the building.</p>	<p>FIGHT – If in imminent danger – act aggressively, yell loudly, throw/use objects as weapons to incapacitate attacker.</p>	<p>3. REMAIN SHELTERED in place until advised by emergency personnel it is safe to exit and be prepared to move to a different safe area or evacuate if advised.</p>
