Driving/Parking Instructions for Tippie Graduate & Professional Advising Appointments

Directions

From Interstate 80: From I-80, take exit 244, Dubuque Street. Go south on Dubuque until Market Street (3rd stoplight, Casey's will be on your left). Turn right onto Market. After about 1-1/2 blocks, you'll see a sign on your right telling you if any of the parking ramps are full. Follow Market Street down the hill to the T-intersection.

Turn right to park in the North Campus Ramp (it is closest to the Pomerantz Center). If the North Campus Ramp is full, turn left to park in the Iowa Memorial Union Parking Ramp.

As a note, before you go down the big hill on the last block of Market Street you will see the **Pomerantz Center** on your right. It is a four-story white building just before the pedestrian crossing, between Old Brick Church and the Chemistry building.

To the Pomerantz Center

From the **North Campus Ramp**, go to level five and follow the walkway south for one block to The Pomerantz Center.

From the **Iowa Memorial Union ramp**, go to level four and exit at the southeast corner. Go up the short set of stairs and turn left onto the T. Anne Cleary Walkway. Cross Market Street (heading north) to the Pomerantz Center.



Pomerantz Center (PC)

C432 Pomerantz Center is on the 4th floor. Take the elevator to the 4th level and turn left down the hallway.

The Tippie Graduate and Professional Programs office is located in Suite C432 on the fourth floor of The Pomerantz Center. When you enter the building, please take either the north or south elevator to the 4th floor. C432 is located toward the middle of the hallway on the 4th floor.

Accessible Parking

Accessible parking spaces are provided in all facility types including ramps, surface lots and meters. Accessible parking locations are shown on the <u>Parking Map</u>. All accessible spaces are striped with blue paint and display ADA Reserved Parking signage with fines listed. Use of these spaces requires a state issued disability parking permit or a disability license plate.

Visitors to campus can use the accessible parking spaces located in public parking facilities and most ADA meters. Most accessible parking spaces in employee parking lots are reserved for employee use only during business hours. Visitor Parking

Visitor parking on campus is available in public parking facilities (gated ramps/lots) and parking meters. Faculty / Staff lots are open to the public on weekdays 4:30 p.m.– 7:30 a.m. and all weekend, unless otherwise posted.
