A minimum of 60 semester hours (typically 20 courses) of unique University of Iowa Tippie Graduate & Professional Programs (GPP) coursework is needed at the time the second degree is awarded. Courses must be less than 10 years old to be used to satisfy a degree requirement. Transfer courses and/or University of Iowa graduate coursework from outside of GPP will NOT count toward the 60 or 90 hour total even if it was applied to one of the degrees.		

To ensure degree requirements are met and policies for multiple degrees are followed, we highly encourage you to meet with your advisor to discuss your specific plan.

- For an overview of business analytics electives, refer to the course descriptions and schedule of courses.
- In Fall 2020, the course subject MSCI was changed to BAIS. On your grade report or audit, you may see a course listed as MSCI:9100 instead of BAIS:9100; this is the same course, just with a different subject code.
- To graduate with your MBA alone, you must complete 45 credit hours (15 classes) and take all of the appropriate courses to meet the degree requirements.
- To graduate with your Part-time Master of Business Analytics alone, you must complete 30 credit hours (10 classes) and take all of the appropriate courses to meet the degree requirements.
- Degree audits for multiple degree students are often incorrect because each degree audit (MBA and Part-time Master of Business Analytics) needs to be adjusted manually so that the courses count correctly. For this reason, you can use the checklist above to monitor your course progress. A single course may not be used on multiple lines above.
