

MBA, Part-time MS Business Analytics, Part-time MS Finance, and/or Professional Certificates Tuition Responsibility Schedule

Please refer to the chart below for tuition responsibility associated with dropping an MBA, Business Analytics, or Finance course in which you are enrolled. Some courses may follow a different responsibility schedule and will thus be noted in the official schedule of courses.

Failure to attend class does not constitute withdrawal.

If you have already paid for the course you are dropping, an adjustment will be made on your university bill when you are held to less than 100% tuition.

MBA: The last day to drop a class without receiving an “F” letter grade is one week before the class end date listed in MyUI. Students would be held to 100% tuition.

MS Business Analytics, Business Analytics Certificate, and MS Finance: the last day to drop a class without receiving an “F” letter grade can be found by looking up the course on the [Course Deadlines](#) webpage and looking at the date for “Last day to drop without collegiate approval, graduate”.
