Policies for the Minor

- At least 12 semester hours of coursework must be completed in the Tippie College of Business (ECON, ACCT, MGMT, MKTG, BAIS and FIN).
- An overall grade-point average of at least 2.00 is required on all courses taken and on courses taken at The University of Iowa. (2.00 GPA on all courses, not each course).
- Course work in the minor may not be taken pass/nonpass⁴.
- Exceptions made for the minor may not satisfy requirements for the Bachelor of Business Administration degree. See an advisor in C140 PBB for more information.

¹Students in the Interdepartmental Studies: Business Studies Track are prohibited from earning the Minor in Business Administration.

²For the minor only, Engineering majors may substitute ISE:2500 Engineering Economy and Actuarial Science majors may substitute FIN:3300 Corporate Finance.

³Of these courses, 12 semester hours must be completed through the Tippie College. The following do not count as Tippie coursework: a) transfer course work or b) course substitutions from departments outside of Tippie (e.g. CS, ENGR, EDTL or ISE)

⁴ Pass grades are accepted for Spring 2020 only.
